Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

This trial is accepting online entries through <u>LabTestedOnline.com</u>. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 30% online entries (105 runs) and 70% paper entries (245 runs). If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 24C height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

PLEASE NOTE: Effective 1/2/18, the 26-inch jump height division is replaced by the 24-Choice jump height division.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs.

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2023

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

MOVE UP REQUESTS

Move ups must be sent in writing (e-mail is acceptable and preferred--NO TEXTS OR INSTANT MESSAGES-- to the Trial Secretary for the June 21, 2024 trial **no later than Monday, June 17, 2024 at 6:00 PM**. Day to day Move ups must be submitted in person to the trial secretary no later than 15 minutes after the last class on Friday and Saturday.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Rubberized contacts will be used. All classes will take place on synthetic turf. Ring size will be a minimum of 78 x 120 square feet. Rubberized Contacts will be used.

Course WALK-THROUGHS AND Warm-Up INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. No umbrellas allowed on course during walk-throughs.

There will be a designated warm-up area inside the building. Please use caution when using the jump and be aware of other dogs waiting to enter the arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

RIBBONS & AWARDS

Flat ribbons will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class on Friday (**GWDC**). Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place dog in each jump height division in each class on Saturday and Sunday (**CVAC**).

- Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. MACH/PACH Rosettes and a MACH/PACH bar will be given to exhibitors earning a MACH/PACH title at this trial.
- **New Title** ribbons will be given to dogs earning a new title.
- Masters, Regular or Preferred, ribbons with streamers indicating STD, JWW, or FAST titles will be awarded to those who reach that level at our trial. Master Century ribbon for dogs reaching their Master Century Titles CVAC only
- Double "Q" ribbons will be given to those exhibitors who double Q in the STD and JWW Master classes on the same day. CVAC and GWDC
- Triple "Q" ribbons will be given to those exhibitors who Q in the STD and JWW and FAST Master classes on the same day. CVAC ONLY
- "Perfect Score" ribbons will be given to exhibitors in the Novice, Open and Excellent classes who qualify with a score of 100 points. CVAC ONLY
- Agility Grand Champion (AGCH) ribbons will be given to those earning this award at this trial

All ribbons must be claimed by the end of the trial; none will be mailed.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not allowed at this trial. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

BIS & INJURY REFUND INFORMATION

Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$3 per run (each day), upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on June 21, 2024.

Injury/Illness – **CVAC ONLY:** Dogs that cannot compete prior to the set of trials due to an injury/illness will be given a partial refund minus processing fees of \$6.50 per run. A written vet letter (on office letterhead) must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on June 22, 2024. **Injuries/illness to handlers are excluded from this policy**

SITE INFORMATION

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

BUILDING & CRATING INFORMATION – No exhibitor setup prior to Friday. There is a limited amount of crating indoors, therefore, priority is given to club members and worker volunteers. If there is additional space available it will be on a first-come, first served basis. Crating is only allowed on the tarps set down by LUDS. Please conserve space as much as possible. The trial committee reserves the right to rearrange setups to fit more dogs in the building. Please do not block aisles.

PARKING & OUTDOOR GROUNDS – Do not park in front of any gate or doorway. Respect the traffic cones when parking; they mark the turning radius for truck traffic in the area. If you are planning on running your vehicle's engine, please park so that your exhaust does not go into a neighboring vehicle nor towards the building. NO OVERNIGHT RVs NOR RV DAY PARKING ARE PERMITTED ON SITE.

PLEASE NOTE: DO NOT POTTY YOUR DOGS ON NEIGHBORING TENANTS' GROUNDS. If you are caught, you will be asked to leave for the weekend and forfeit your runs. Dogs must be kept on leash at all times.

FOOD – There is no on-site catering. No food will be provided on Saturday and Sunday. The Greater Washington Dalmatian Club will offer water, snacks, and a light lunch on Friday.

AGILITY GATE & COURSE MAPS – The Agility Gate app will be used for the running order for the trial. All course maps will be available on Agility Gate and a paper copy of each course will be posted at the trial. There will be no paper course map copies for distribution to exhibitors.

PLEASE NOTE: The Agility Gate app is an aid only – it is still the responsibility of the handler to make sure they are at their walkthroughs and are at the gate when it is their turn to run. GWDC/CVAC are not responsible for any delays in communications due to technical difficulties with wireless networks.

RING/TURF INFORMATION – The ring is indoors in a climate-controlled building with turf flooring. Handlers need shoes with low traction to avoid "sticking" to the turf. Athletic shoes with less tread are recommended.

All turf accidents must be reported immediately and a \$5 clean up fee must be paid to Level Up Dog Sports.

When running your dog, per AKC guidelines: "Exhibitors may choose to place leashes in their pockets or wear them (around waist, cross body, etc.) during their runs. If the dog grabs the leash, this will be scored as an "E". If the leash falls out of the handler's pocket, or off their body, there is no call unless the dog were to grab it." A leash runner will be available for exhibitors who do not wish to carry their leash while on course.

• For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

• FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us).

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and <u>may not</u> compete in a jump height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
