MOVE-UPS

Move-ups due to titles earned will be accepted until Monday 02/09/2026 at 6 PM, and should be e-mailed to the trial secretary at christina.tracey@outlook.com. Move-ups may also be submitted day-to-day at the trial (for the following trial day). All move-ups done at the trial for the next day must be done in writing via the Move-Up Sheet provided on the results table, no later than 15 minutes after the end of the trial.

WAITLIST INFORMATION

This trial currently has no waitlists.

TRIAL SCHEDULE / RUNNING ORDER / COURSE MAPS

Building opens at 7:00 AM. Check-in is at 7:30 AM, and the judge's briefing and walk-thru is at 7:45 AM. For Friday and Sunday, judging begins in Ring 1 with all levels of FAST at 8:00 AM, then alternating between Ring 1 and Ring 2. For Saturday, judging begins in Ring 2 with Time 2 Beat at 8:00 AM, then alternating between Ring 2 and Ring 1.

Jump height order for each class will be: Small to Tall (4" to 24") on Friday and Sunday, and Tall to Small (24" to 4") on Saturday. Our judge for all classes will be Karl Blakely.

A preliminary running order (before move-ups) will be posted on my website, www.triaddogagility.com, as well as a projected timeline for the trial to help you determine when you will need to be available to walk your course or carry out your volunteer assignments. Remember, this is only an estimate, so arrive in plenty of time before your first run! Please refer to the premium, estimated timeline, and worker schedule for the complete class running order for each day.

This trial will be using AGILITY GATE for check-in, daily running order, and course maps; **THE AGILITY GATE CODE WILL BE 8340**. In addition, printed maps will be posted daily at the trial site for photographing.

The Friday/Sunday walkthrough groupings for EXCELLENT/MASTERS classes will be as follows:

- SMALL DOGS (4"-8"-12") will WALK, then RUN
- LARGE DOGS (16"-20"-24") will WALK, then RUN

The Saturday walkthrough groupings for EXCELLENT/MASTERS classes will be as follows:

- LARGE DOGS (24"-20"-16") will WALK, then RUN
- SMALL DOGS (12"-8"-4") will WALK, then RUN

All levels of FAST classes will be merged and run in height order. All other classes will have one walkthrough.

MEASURING

We will have one VMO, Alexandra Davis, present at this trial. If your dog needs to be measured, please arrive at the trial site well in advance of your first run to give the VMO plenty of time to measure your dog. Please be considerate of her time as she is very busy with running her own dogs as well. **Please refer to the AKC measuring guidelines at <https://www.akc.org/sports/agility/exhibitor-resources/jump-height-card/> to determine if your dog must be measured by the VMO at the trial.**

DIRECTIONS to RISING STAR CANINE RANCH (8340 W. Harrell Rd., Oak Ridge, NC 27310)

From the south: I-77N, take exit 13A onto I-85N toward Greensboro. Take exit 87 onto I-285 toward Winston-Salem. Take exit 107A onto US-311/I-40E toward Greensboro/High Point. Take exit 201 toward Union Cross Road, continue 4mi. Continue via Main St (NC-150) for .6mi, turn right onto N Main St (NC-150) and continue 6mi (turns into Oak Ridge Road). Turn left onto NC-68N for 2.8mi, turn left onto Haw River Road for 1.5mi, turn left onto West Harrell Rd. for 1mi.

From the north/east: I-85S to I-40W toward Greensboro. Take exit 210 onto NC-68 toward airport. Continue for 10mi, turn left onto Haw River Road for 1.5mi, turn left onto West Harrell Road for 1mi.

From the west: I-40E toward Greensboro. Take left exit 188 onto US-421S toward Winston-Salem, continue for 15.8mi. Take exit 222 NC-150 toward Kernersville, then turn left onto NC-66S for .8mi, then turn right onto N Main St (NC-150) and continue 6mi (turns into Oak Ridge Road). Turn left onto NC-68N for 2.8mi, turn left onto Haw River Road for 1.5mi, turn left onto West Harrell Road for 1mi.

PARKING & CRATING

Request forms for reserved parking and downstairs crating will no longer be accepted now that the trial has closed. There is additional parking up the hill; please angle cars on the hill and park close to cars already parked. There is additional crating upstairs on the balcony with an area for some chairs to view the agility area. No x-pens (hard or soft), tent-type crates, or large chairs please. **THOSE WITH RESERVED PARKING AND/OR DOWNSTAIRS CRATING MUST VOLUNTEER TO WORK DAILY.** If you are having difficulty at the trial with someone parked in your reserved parking space, or if you cannot find your reserved downstairs crating spot, please see **Sandy Fisher** at the trial for assistance.

CLEAN-UP FEE

Please be aware that RSCR charges a \$20 fee per occurrence clean-up fee if you or your dog soil one of the rings. We hope that this does not happen, but if it does, please be understanding when the club asks you for payment. If you have questions, please talk to the RSCR owner, Melissa Tiedemann.

If you could help by volunteering for just one class per day, we would really appreciate it! **SNACKS EACH DAY AND LUNCH ON SATURDAY WILL BE PROVIDED FOR WORKERS.** Please plan to bring your own snacks, drinks, and/or lunch as there will be no food truck, nor are there nearby fast-food restaurants. There is a microwave available for competitor use.

PLEASE NOTE: Bottled water WILL NOT be provided. The facility has a filtered water fountain specially designed for refilling cups and water bottles. **PLEASE PLAN TO BRING YOUR OWN WATER BOTTLE** to refill. Disposable cups will also be provided for those that forget to bring their own refillable water container.

MASSAGE

Beverly Adams (Blue Ridge Therapeutic Massage) will be at the trial all three days to provide canine and handler massage.
